

Enhanced powers for the Registrar of Companies (coming into force on 4 March 2024) are aimed at improving the quality of the information available at Companies House.

The Registrar will have the power to query, reject or remove documents submitted for filing if there is a reason to believe that the details are inconsistent with other information shown on the records held at Companies House. The Registrar will also be able to request additional information and to annotate a document on the public register if there is uncertainty regarding the information disclosed.
